San Joaquin RTD to Provide Free Rides to "Neighbors in Health"

(Stockton, CA) – San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) is once again providing free bus rides to the Annual "Neighbors in Health" (NIH) health fair on Sunday, August 16, at Kaiser Permanente's Stockton location. NIH works toward creating a healthier community by offering uninsured and underinsured families the opportunity to receive various medical services at no cost. This year's NIH is presented by United Way of San Joaquin, with Kaiser Permanente providing major support including the location and facilities. The fair runs from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., and will provide free medical and dental screenings for thousands. Services include: adult and pediatric health exams, immunizations, blood pressure screenings, cholesterol and glucose screenings, dental screenings, STD screenings, vision screenings, and health education.

To ride free, passengers must tell the driver that they are going to the "Neighbors in Health" event at the Stockton Kaiser Permanente location.
