RTD to Begin Channel Street Passenger Amenities Improvement Project

(Stockton, CA) – On Monday, February 22, 2010, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will begin its Channel Street Passenger Amenities Improvement Project, which will improve the passenger boarding area along the south side of Channel Street at the Downtown Transit Center (DTC). When the project is complete, RTD customers will enjoy a more comfortable and attractive boarding area with new bus benches, added seating from seatwall planter boxes, and landscaping to provide shade and beauty.

During construction, one block of eastbound Channel Street, between Sutter and California Streets, will be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic and Routes 23, 26, 27, 90, and 91 will move to the north side of Channel (across the street from their regular boarding location); the RTD-BART Commuter will board and deboard customers on the southwest corner of Sutter and Channel Streets. During construction, DTC customers using these buses must use the crosswalks on Channel Street at Sutter and California Streets to get to and from their buses and the DTC. RTD is reminding passengers and motorists that fines are doubled in the construction zone. Construction is scheduled to be completed by the end of March.
