Limited, Demand-Response Bus Service Available on Labor Day

(Stockton, CA) – On Labor Day, Monday, September 1, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will close its administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) and will not operate its regular fixed route bus services (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter) and Dial-A-Ride services.

A limited, demand-response service will be available by reservation only on a first-come, first-served basis at a premium fare of \$5 per one-way trip. This service is available within the Stockton Metropolitan Area only. Priority will be given to seniors and persons with disabilities.

Reservations will be accepted beginning Monday, August 25, until 5:00 p.m. Thursday, August 28. Reservations will be limited to one round trip per passenger. For reservations, please call (209) 955-8400. RTD is not operating this service. RTD's contractor is operating it, similar to the services that the contractor usually operates.

RTD will resume regularly scheduled service and reopen its administrative offices and the DTC on Tuesday, September 2.
