## **Limited, Demand-Response Bus Service Available on Thanksgiving Day**

(Stockton, CA) – On Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 27, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will close its administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) and will not operate its regular fixed route bus services (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter) and Dial-A-Ride services.

A limited, demand-response service will be available by reservation only on a first-come, first-served basis at a premium fare of \$3 per one-way for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) certified customers and \$5 per one-way for General Public (GP) customers. Priority will be given to seniors and persons with disabilities.

Reservations will be accepted beginning Tuesday, November 18, until 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 25. Reservations will be limited to one round trip per passenger. For reservations, please call (209) 955-8400. RTD is not operating this service. RTD's contractor is operating it, similar to the services that the contractor usually operates.

RTD will resume regularly scheduled service Friday, November 28, and reopen its administrative offices and the DTC on Monday, December 1.

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
