Limited, Demand-Response Bus Service Available on Easter Sunday

(Stockton, CA) – On Easter Sunday, April 5, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will close its administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) and will not operate its regular fixed routes bus services (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter) and Dial-A-Ride services.

A limited, demand-response service will be available by reservation only on a first-come, first-served basis at a fare of \$3 per one-way for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) certified customers and \$5 per one-way for General Public (GP) customers. Priority will be given to seniors and persons with disabilities.

Reservations will be accepted beginning Tuesday, March 31, until 5:00 p.m. Friday, April 3. Reservations will be limited to one round trip per passenger. For reservations, please call (209) 955-8400. RTD is not operating this service. RTD's contractor is operating it.

RTD will resume regularly scheduled service* and reopen its administrative offices and the DTC on Monday, April 6.

* Commuter Route 152 will resume regular scheduled service on Tuesday, April 7.
