Limited, Demand-Response Bus Service Available on Labor Day

On Monday, September 7, in honor of the Labor Day holiday, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate its regular fixed-route bus service (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter) and Dial-A-Ride service. RTD's administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) will be closed.

A limited, demand-response service will be available by reservation only on a first-come, first-served basis at a fare of \$5 per one-way trip for RTD's guests. Priority will be given to seniors and persons with disabilities. The service will operate countywide from 7:15am to 5:00pm.

Reservations will be accepted during office hours beginning Monday, August 31, through Friday, September 4. Reservations will be limited to one round trip per passenger. For reservations, please call (209) 955-8400. RTD's contractor is operating this service. RTD will resume regularly scheduled service and reopen its administrative offices and the DTC on Tuesday, September 8.
