## **Limited, Demand-Response Bus Service Available on Thanksgiving Day**

(Stockton, CA) – On Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 26, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will close its administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) and will not operate its regular fixed route bus services (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter) and Dial-A-Ride services.

A limited, demand-response service will be available by reservation only on a first-come, first-served basis at a fare of \$5 per one-way trip for RTD's guests. Priority will be given to seniors and persons with disabilities.

Reservations will be accepted beginning Thursday, November 19, until 5:00 p.m. Tuesday, November 24. Reservations will be limited to one round trip per passenger. For reservations, please call (209) 955-8400. RTD is not operating this service. RTD's contractor is operating it.

RTD will resume regularly scheduled service on Friday, November 27, and reopen its administrative offices and the DTC on Monday, November 30.
