Limited, demand-response bus service available on Easter Sunday

(Stockton, CA) – On Easter Sunday, March 27, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate regular fixed routes bus services (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter) or Dial-A-Ride services.

A limited, demand-response service will be available by reservation only on a first-come, first-served basis at a fare of \$3 per one-way trip for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) certified customers and \$5 per one-way trip for General Public (GP) customers. Priority will be given to seniors and persons with disabilities.

Reservations will be accepted until Thursday, March 24 at 5:00 p.m. Reservations will be limited to one round trip per passenger. For reservations, please call (209) 955-8400. This service is being operated by RTD's contractor.

RTD will resume regularly scheduled service and reopen its administrative offices and the Downtown Transit Center on Monday, March 28.
