RTD to host community event for National Night Out

(Stockton, CA) – On Tuesday, August 2, in honor of National Night Out 2016, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will host a free community event to promote crime prevention and safety awareness. The event will take place at the Downtown Transit Center (DTC), 421 E. Weber Avenue, Stockton, from 3:00 – 6:00 pm.

RTD will highlight bus safety measures, its role in the national Safe Place program, its participation in the “See Something, Say Something” campaign, and its partnership with the Stockton Police and Stockton Unified School District Police Departments. RTD will also provide information on how to ride the bus to other community National Night Out events.

Food, beverages, and children’s activities will be available. Neighboring downtown businesses, organizations, and vendors will also be invited to share information and activities with attendees.

About National Night Out

National Night Out is an annual crime prevention event that involves citizens, law enforcement, public agencies, civic groups, businesses, neighborhood organizations, and local officials from over 16,000 across the nation. National Night Out is designed to heighten crime and drug prevention awareness, generate support for, and participation in, local anticrime programs, and strengthen neighborhood and community partnerships.
