RTD to offer free rides for Veterans and Service Members

(Stockton, CA) – On November 11, in honor of Veterans Day, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) is proud to offer free rides to veterans and active-duty service members on all RTD routes. The free ride offer is valid on November 11 only and only for residents of San Joaquin County.

Participating passengers must identify themselves to RTD coach operators as veterans, including their branch and years of service. Veterans who are current Dial-A-Ride customers should also identify themselves as veterans when making their Dial-A-Ride reservation. For verification, veterans or active-duty service members should bring a state-issued ID and either a Form DD214, a Discount card from San Joaquin County Veterans Services, or a Military ID.

Please note, RTD administrative offices, including the Downtown Transit Center (DTC), will be closed for Veterans Day. Additionally, RTD will operate its weekend schedule for fixed-route bus services, and operate limited service for its interregional commuter routes.

The following fixed routes will operate on their Saturday/Sunday schedules:

- Metro Express Routes 40, 43, and 44
- Stockton Metro Area (SMA) Routes 710, 715, 720, 725, and 745
- County Routes 723 and 797
- SMA ADA Dial-A-Ride
- Countywide Rural General Public Dial-A-Ride

The following Commuter Routes will operate their regular schedules:

- Routes 150, 152, 163, 164, 166, 172, and 173
- Route 165 passengers can use Route 163
