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Limited, demand-response bus service available on Thanksgiving Day

(Stockton, CA) — On Thanksgiving Day, Thursday, November 24, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate regular fixed route bus services (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, Hopper, and San Joaquin Commuter) and Dial-A-Ride services. RTD administrative offices, RTD's call center, and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) will also be closed.

RTD's contractor will operate a limited, demand-response service of only 15 one-way trips within the Stockton Metropolitan Area, available by reservation on a first-come, first-served basis at a fare of \$5 per one-way trip. Priority will be given to seniors and persons with disabilities. Reservations will be accepted between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm from Thursday, November 17, through Tuesday, November 22, and will be limited to one round-trip per passenger. RTD will resume regular weekday service on Friday, November 25, however, only the Commuter Routes below will operate on their regular schedule that day:

- Routes 150 and 163
- Route 165 passengers can use Route 163
