RTD Service Plan for BART Work Stoppage

RTD is monitoring the status of the potential Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) work stoppage that could begin as early as Monday, July 1.

At this time, RTD plans to continue providing regularly scheduled service on the RTD-BART Commuter (Route 150) in the event of a work stoppage.

RTD is in contact with BART and Bay Area Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) staff to identify service alternatives for transit commuters. RTD will continue to keep you updated on this situation as we receive new information, and will notify you about any service changes or parallel service opportunities as soon as they become available.
