- RTD had a significant decrease in the amount of customer comments
  despite recent service modifications. I would like to acknowledge and
  thank RTD staff for their outreach efforts. Also, last month ALC staff
  provided reasons for the increase in Dial-A-Ride comments and made a
  commitment to resolve the issues. ALC delivered on their promise and
  Dial-A-Ride comments have decreased.
- There is overcrowding on the Routes 23 and 93. This is being addressed by improving service frequency.

- Operations Superintendent Norm Tuitavuki and Executive and Board Support Manager Shelly Valenton reported on an ongoing study to address fare evasion on RTD's Bus Rapid Transit Service.
- Grants Manager George Lorente provided a presentation on legislative meetings with Congressman Jerry McNerney and Congressman Dennis Cardoza's staff to discuss RTD's pending Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery Grant application for the Regional Transportation Center.
- Marketing and Communications Manager Paul Rapp reported that RTD's Stuff the Bus Event collected nearly 25,000 pounds of food.
- Facilities Superintendent Wendell Krell, Operations Superintendent Mark Fairbanks, and Planning Manager Nathaniel Atherstone provided an update on the final session of the Environmental Sustainability Management Systems (ESMS) Training.
