RTD To Operate Weekend Service Schedule On Martin Luther King, Jr. Day

Stockton, CA – On Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Monday, January 15, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will operate its Weekend Service Schedule for the below routes:

- Metro Express Routes 40, 43, and 44
- Weekend Routes 710, 715, 720, 725, and 745
- County Fixed Routes 723 and 797
- Stockton Metropolitan Area (SMA) Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Dial-A-Ride (DAR)

The following Commuter Routes will operate regular weekday service, Bart 150, 163 (Passengers can use in place of Route 165), 172, and 173. Additionally, RTD's administrative offices, Downtown Transit Center (DTC) and call center will be closed. All RTD services and operations will resume normal schedules on Tuesday, January 16.
