Limited Service on Veterans Day Observed – November 12

Stockton, CA –In observance of Veterans Day, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will close its administrative offices, call center, and Downtown Transit Center (DTC) on Monday, November 12. RTD will operate limited weekend service on regular fixed-route (Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, and Hopper) and Dial-A-Ride services. All Commuter Services will operate regular service, except Route 165 which will be out of service.
