RTD Operates Modified Schedule on Martin Luther King Jr. Day

Stockton, CA —In observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day on Monday, January 21, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will operate with the below modified schedule.

- The following routes will operate a weekend service schedule:
 - Metro Express Routes 40, 43, 44, 47, and 49.
 - Stockton Metropolitan Area (SMA) and County Hopper Routes 710, 715, 720, 723, 725, 745, and 797
 - Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Dial-A-Ride (DAR)
- The following Commuter Routes will operate regular weekday service:
 - 150 (BART), 163 (Passengers can use Route 163 in place of Route 165), 172, and 173.
- RTD Go (Uber) will be available for morning and evening rides. Please visit sjRTD.com/RTDGo for details.
- RTD Van Go will be available for daytime rides in northern San Joaquin County only. Please see sjRTD.com/vango for more information.

RTD's administrative offices, Downtown Transit Center (DTC), and call center will be closed on Monday. All RTD services and operations will resume their normal schedules on Tuesday, January 22. For route and schedule information, visit sjRTD.com.
