### **RTD Operates Modified Schedule on Presidents Day**

Stockton, CA—In observance of Presidents Day on Monday, February 18, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will operate with the below modified schedule:

- The following routes will operate a weekend service schedule:
  - Metro Express Routes 40, 43, 44, 47, and 49.
  - Stockton Metropolitan Area (SMA) and County Hopper Routes 710, 715, 720, 723, 725, 745, and 797
  - Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Dial-A-Ride (DAR)
- The following Commuter Routes will operate regular weekday service:
  - 150 (BART), 163 (Passengers can use Route 163 in place of Route 165), 172, and 173.
