RTD's New Van Go! Service Available on Easter Sunday

Stockton, CA—In observance of Easter on Sunday, April 21, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will offer its newest mobility on-demand service in place of its regular services (all fixed-route and Dial-A-Ride) that will not be operating on that day.

Van Go! mobility on-demand service will be available from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. Passengers may book a ride the minute they need it or up to two days in advance by using the RTD Van Go! app. Download of the RTD Van Go! app is available from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.
