## **RTD Implements Changes to Improve Efficiency**

Stockton, CA—San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) is implementing the following service modifications on Sunday, July 28. “After studying our routes, we’ve decided that these changes will make our service more efficient,” said RTD CEO Donna DeMartino. “Our goal is always to provide the highest level of service to the greatest number of people with the resources we have available. We believe this realignment of our services will achieve that and is responsive to the demonstrated needs of our customers.”

**New** service times and destinations have been added to the following routes:

- Metro Hopper 3
- Metro Hopper 9
- Route 163
- Route 335

**Regular** service for the following routes that were suspended during the summer months will resume:

- Route 340
- Route 360
- Route 380
- Route 390

Time changes on the following routes will improve efficiency and maintain connectivity:

- Commuter Route 150
- Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Route 44
- BRT Route 47
- BRT Route 49
- Route 576
- Route 580
- Route 720
- Route 745

Service for discontinued local routes will be integrated into other routes as follows:

- **Route 535** will now be integrated into limited service **Route 335** with stops including Stagg High School and Walmart.
- **Route 570** will now be integrated into **Metro Hopper 3** with stops including Kaiser Medical Offices and the Tam O’Shanter loop.
- **Route 577** will now be integrated into **Metro Hopper 9** with stops in the Wilson Way-Waterloo Corridor.
