RTD Modifies Service Schedule in Observance of Presidents Day

Stockton, CA—In observance of Presidents Day (Monday, February 17), San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will operate its weekend service schedule for its Stockton Metro, Metro Express, Intercity, and Hopper service.

For Commuter service, RTD will not operate its Commuter Route 152 but will offer regular service for Commuter Route 150. It will also offer a modified schedule for Commuter Route 163.

RTD Van Go! will also be available from 6:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. Passengers may book a ride up to two days in advance using the RTD Van Go! app, which is available for download from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. For more information regarding the service, visit sjRTD.com/VanGo

RTD's administrative offices, Downtown Transit Center (DTC), and call center will be closed. Regular service and operations will resume on Tuesday, February 18.
