"As a public service agency, we want to provide essential service to those in need while encouraging all those who can stay at home to do so."

RTD will continue to offer weekend service until further notice. To protect our bus operators and passengers during this time of social distancing, RTD asks that all passengers who do not require accommodation to board through the rear of the bus. Passengers in wheelchairs may still use the front door. This is among other precautions RTD is implementing to ensure the safety of our operators and the public.
