In its place, RTD offers Van Go!, its on-demand service for lifeline purposes only, from 6:00 a.m. – 8:00 p.m. Passengers may book a ride up to two days in advance by using the RTD Van Go! app. The app is available from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.
