RTD Observes Labor Day on September 7

Stockton, CA— In observance of Labor Day, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate its fixed routes, Hopper, Dial-A-Ride, or Commuter services on Monday, September 7. Its administrative offices, call center, and Downtown Transit Center (DTC) will also be closed.

RTD's newly redesigned Van Go!—that offers seamless countywide travel—will be available from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on that day. Eligible trips must begin or end in rural or unincorporated areas of San Joaquin County. Passengers may book a ride up to 48 hours in advance using the RTD Van Go! app that is available for download from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.
