RTD Van Go!

Seamless trips throughout San Joaquin County with no transfers required.

So what's new?

- Service time change.
8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
7 days a week
- New fare structure
- No more transfers from zone to zone

How does it work?

You can take Van Go! trips as long as the origin or destination of the trip is in the burgundy area of the map (rural or unincorporated County).

What stays the same?

Van Go! is still a rideshare service provided in vehicles that are safe and accessible (can transport wheelchairs). Drivers are professionally trained and ready to help.

Note: Vehicles cannot transport bicycles.

Example:

- YES**
- Lockeford to Stockton
 - Stockton (in burgundy) to Stockton (in gray)
 - Any city (in burgundy) to any city (in burgundy)

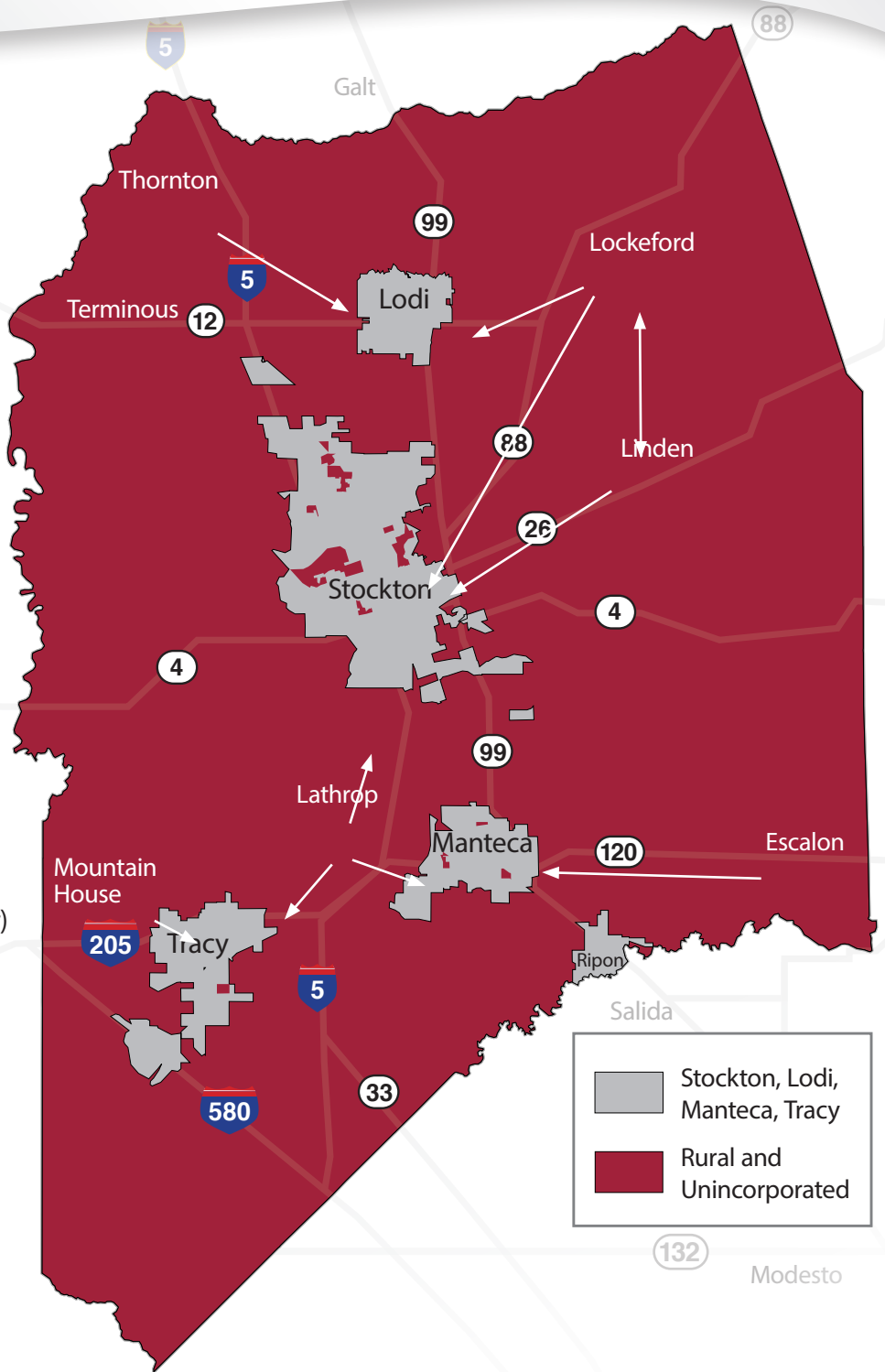
- NO**
- Lodi to Stockton
 - Stockton (in gray) to Stockton (in gray)
 - Any city (in gray) to any city (in gray)

Fare:

- \$4.00 one-way base fare per passenger for the first five miles
- \$0.50 per mile after the 5th mile

Example: 22 mile one-way trip from Lockford to Stockton:

\$4.00 base fare for first five miles
 + \$8.50 = 17 miles @ \$0.50 per mile
 \$12.50 = Total cost to passenger
