## **RTD Offers Modified Service on Veterans Day**

Stockton, CA— On Wednesday, November 11, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will operate modified service in observance of Veterans Day by offering weekend service schedule for its fixed-route and its regular service for Van Go! and Commuter Route 163 and 150. RTD's administrative offices, call center, and the Downtown Transit Center will be closed. Regular service and operations will resume on Thursday, November 12.

RTD will also offer free rides on that day to veterans and active-duty service members. Eligible passengers will need to present a state-issued I.D. and one of the following forms of identification:

- Form DD214 for veterans.
- Discount card from San Joaquin County Veterans Services.
- Current military I.D.

"We want to thank our veterans and active-duty service members," said RTD's CEO Gloria Salazar. "We appreciate their service to our nation, and welcome the opportunity to serve them." RTD is proud to showcase its Veterans Bus everyday—especially on Veterans Day. This specially-wrapped RTD bus honors soldiers in all the military branches who have served and continue to serve our nation. Those visiting the Downtown Transit Center may view the RTD "Veterans Wall," a photographic collage of RTD employees and family members who have served in the military.
