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## **RTD Offers Limited Service on Thanksgiving Day**

Stockton, CA— On Thanksgiving Day, November 26, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate its regular fixed-route service (Local, BRT, Intercity, Hopper, and Commuter Services). RTD's administrative offices, call center, and the Downtown Transit Center will be closed.

RTD Van Go! will be available from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m. on that day. Passengers may book a ride up to two days in advance using the RTD Van Go! app, which is available for download from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store.
