Stockton, CA—In observance of Memorial Day, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not be running its Commuter or fixed-route service on Monday, May 31. In its place, RTD offers its on-demand service Van Go! from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.
