RTD Offers Limited Service on Fourth of July

Stockton, CA—In observance of Independence Day, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate its regular fixed-route service on Sunday, July 4. In its place, RTD offers Van Go!, its on-demand service for lifeline purposes only, from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.

RTD will resume regular service for all routes on Monday July 5; the call center and DTC will be open that day. RTD administrative offices will reopen on Tuesday, July 6.
