RTD Restores More Public Transit Service

Stockton, CA—In response to the more than expected number of students returning to in-person learning versus distance learning in Stockton area high schools, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will increase more routes on Monday August 9, 2021. RTD was informed this week after school began that out of 2,400 students attending Chavez High school, only 80 opted for online instruction. Out of 2,200 students attending Stagg High school, only 60 opted for online instruction.

“As promised, RTD closely monitored its overall ridership and based on the data we have gathered, made this determination,” said CEO Gloria G. Salazar. “We are encouraged by the increase in ridership and will continue to provide the highest level of service to the greatest number of people within our resources.” The following are transit routes that are open to the public and serve the following Stockton area high schools:
