RTD Offers Limited Service on Thanksgiving Day

Stockton, CA—On Thanksgiving Day, November 25, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate its regular fixed-route and Commuter service. RTD's administrative offices, call center, and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) will be closed.

RTD Van Go! will be available from 8:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. on that day. Passengers may book a ride up to two days in advance using the RTD Van Go! app, which is available for download from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. On Friday, November 26, RTD will resume regular weekday service for all routes; RTD's administrative offices, DTC, and the call center will reopen on Monday, November 29.
