Stockton, CA—In observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day January 17, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will offer weekend schedule service for its fixed route and regular service for Van Go! and Commuter Route 150. RTD's administrative offices, call center, and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) will be closed.
