Stockton, CA—In observance of Independence Day, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will not operate its regular fixed-route services (Local, Express, Hopper, and Commuter) and Dial-A-Ride services on Monday, July 4. RTD's administrative offices, call center, and the Downtown Transit Center (DTC) will also be closed.
