RTD Partners with Assemblymember Carlos Villapudua To Offer Free Rides to Veterans Stand Down

Stockton, CA— In partnership with Assemblymember Carlos Villapudua, San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) will be providing free transportation to and from the Veterans Stand Down on the Express, Local, Hopper, and ADA Dial-A-Ride services only. This event will be held at the Martin Luther King Plaza at 2 East Oak Street in Stockton from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Tuesday, November 22, 2022.

This one-day event offer veterans and their families the use of RTD transit to access valuable services and resources including housing assistance, employment information, medical and dental exams, mental health consultation, food services, and much more.

"We are honored to partner with Assemblymember Carlos Villapudua to provide free transportation for our veterans so they can easily access these important resources," said RTD CEO Alex Clifford. "This event is a great opportunity for our veterans and their families to connect with the community and receive the support they need."

To ride free, simply let the bus driver know they are going to the event. The event location is just a three-minute walk from the following RTD's bus stops:

- Express Route 40 at Fremont and Commerce Street
- Hopper Route 4 at Oak and El Dorado Street
- Local Route 578 at Oak and El Dorado Street; and at Park and Center Street
