RTD Monitoring Community Activity, Focused on Safe and Reliable Bus Service

Stockton, CA— San Joaquin Regional Transit District (RTD) is aware of reports and public social media posts indicating large gatherings occurring in various parts of Stockton.

RTD is actively monitoring conditions and coordinating internally to help ensure bus service continues to operate as safely and reliably as possible, with the goal of minimizing disruptions for riders.

At this time:

- RTD has not implemented any systemwide service changes
- Buses will continue operating on regular schedules where conditions allow
- Minor delays may occur in areas experiencing increased pedestrian activity or traffic congestion

RTD may implement temporary detours as needed to prioritize the safety of passengers, employees, and individuals participating in large gatherings.

RTD's top priority remains the safety of riders, employees, and the community. Road supervisors and operations staff are positioned throughout the system to respond in real time, and bus operators are trained to adjust service as conditions require.

Riders are encouraged to:

- Allow extra travel time when traveling through areas with large gatherings
- Follow RTD service alerts for real-time updates
- Listen to onboard announcements from bus operators

RTD will continue to monitor conditions throughout the day and will provide updates if service impacts become necessary.
